ORDER

Defendants' February 18, 2009 unopposed motion to compel mediation and for extension of time is granted.

Accordingly, the parties must mediate this case on or before March 30, 2009. The mediator must submit a report to the court within five days of the mediation.

Each individual defendant and its representative or representatives must attend the mediation. A representative of each insurance carrier listed on Exhibit "A" must attend the mediation.

All motions and briefing deadlines, including the supplemental briefing on decertification, and plaintiffs' response to defendants' motion to certify interlocutory appeal, are extended to April 30, 2009.

The court will not rule on defendants' motion to certify interlocutory appeal until after the stay expires.

Plaintiffs' expert reports and their response to defendants' motion to limit designation of class membership are stayed until 30 days after the court rules on certification.
